*One of the oldest festivals in the world is celebrated in some countries in Asia, like Turkey, Iran and Afghanistan. The festival is nearly 4,000 years old and it's called, **Nevruz, Novruz or Norooz.***



Norooz is celebrated in March to welcome the New Year. It lasts for thirteen days. On the first day, fires are lit and people jump over them to bring good luck in the New Year.

For example in Iran, in every home a special table is prepared. Seven different things are put on the table to celebrate Norooz. The name of each thing must begin with the letter 's' in Persian. People put flowers, fruit, coins, candles, mirrors, and even goldfish on their table. Actually every item is a symbol of Fertility, Abundance*, Wealth*, etc. There's a lot of eating and dancing during Nooruz. On the last day of the festival it's bad luck to stay inside your house, so everyone eats outside. A lot of people leave the cities and go to the country for a picnic.*
